Latest update on COVID-19 impact

We would therefore like to reassure customers that SPAL operations in Italy remain normal and have not been affected by the measures brought into place to cope with the virus. Our Group CEO Mr Alessandro Spaggiari has confirmed that despite restrictions in force until April 3rd 2020 on public social activities and events, people in Italy are still permitted to go to work and, vitally, goods are still moving freely.

SPAL has had no reported cases of COVID-19, either in Italy or in the UK. In Italy, all employees are working normally and products flow has been uninterrupted.

In the UK, some of our staff are working from home, but continue to be available to customers on usual contact numbers and emails. Our aim is to ensure that customers receive the same service they have come to expect from SPAL during these challenging times.

In Italy and in the UK, we have implemented all possible internal measures to further reduce the risk of an outbreak and to minimize the impact on individuals and businesses in case this should happen.

SPAL UK has been advised that our HQ in Italy is managing closely any critical contingency in the supply chain and at present, they do not foresee any disruption, nor are they aware currently of any impact to delivery schedules.

In the UK, we had prepared rigorously for potential supply chain interruption resulting from Brexit and so are very well stocked with the products our customers need.
